

Playing players up – a simple guide

Imagine for simplicity your club has 3 teams, A, B, C

Players registered for the A team can only play for the A team.

Players registered for the B team can only play for the A or B team. Once they have played their third match for the A team they will be re-registered to the A and can only play for the A team going forward.

Players registered for the C team can play for the A, B or C team. Once they have played 3 matches for teams other than the C team they have to be re-registered.

- 1) if they have only played up for the A team they will be re-registered for the A team
- 2) if they have only played up for the B team they will be re-registered for the B team and can only play for the B team going forward.
- 3) if they have played up in both the A and B teams then the club must decide which team to re-register them to (A or B). They can then only play matches for that team going forward.

Players can never play for a team lower than the team they are registered for.

All players must be registered for a specific team at the start of the season.

New players can be registered during the season by contacting the League match secretary.
